Recommended Action: Inspect all HS-1204 FWD INBD RIBS (6/kit) for cracks.

Time of Compliance: Prior to installation of the ribs or before the next condition

inspection.

Synopsis:

Prior to installation, customer found crack in stiffening flange of HS-1204 FWD INBD RIB. Structurally these cracks do not present a safety of flight risk. However, builders are encouraged to inspect affected parts and to take corrective action if cracks are found.

Parts shipped before November 5, 2010 are not affected by this notification.

Method of Compliance:

In order to comply with this notification the following action should be taken:

- 1. Inspect all HS-1204 rib stiffening flanges for cracks. See illustrations on page 2.
- 2. If crack is found repair rib per the modification procedures listed below.
- 3. If rib is installed and not accessible to repair make a log book entry and inspect for propagation at or before next annual condition inspection. Contact Van's Aircraft for further instructions.
- 4. Place a copy of this notification in the back of the maintenance manual for your aircraft.
