REVISION DESCRIPTION:

Page: 42D-31 REV 3: In Figure 1, revise the text of the Passenger Warning label to include the text stated in ASTM F2245-16c §9.1.4 "Passenger Warning—This aircraft was manufactured in accordance with Light Sport Aircraft airworthiness standards and does not conform to standard category airworthiness requirements."

Page: 43B-08 REV 3: Remove: "NOTE: F-1200 is for ELSA and F-1200SLSA is for SLSA. F-1200 will be referenced in the text for the remainder of this section."

In Figure 1, remove the depiction of the ELSA placard and the ELSA and SLSA callouts.

Show the correct placard on the instrument panel to read as stated in 9.1.4 (See '42D-31' above.)

In Step 1, "Install the SLSA or ELSA passenger warning label as appropriate from the F-1200 ..." S.B. "Install the passenger warning label from the F-1200 ..."

Delete: "Step 2: Navigate to the Van's Aircraft web site downloads page. Download and install the latest SkyView Software and Settings 12-SVXX.X-PRE-SETS-MM-DD-YY-X.duc on both screens (this will also install the latest firmware)."

Add: "Step 2: Follow the Read-Me to install the latest software and settings on both screens."

Delete: "Download then load all the applicable. dfg settings files onto the pilot side screen. Perform a Network Configuration as described in the Read-Me to push all the settings to the second screen."

Page: 43C-05 REV 2: Remove: "NOTE: F-1200 is for ELSA and F-1200SLSA is for SLSA. F-1200 will be referenced in the text for the remainder of this section."

In Figure 1, remove the depiction of the ELSA placard and the ELSA and SLSA callouts.

Show the correct placard on the instrument panel to read as stated in 9.1.4 (See '42D-31' above.)

In Step 4, "Install the SLSA or ELSA passenger warning label as appropriate from the F-1200 ..." S.B. "Install the passenger warning label from the F-1200 ..."

Page: 51A-02 REV 5: Remove: "NOTE: F-1200 is for ELSA and F-1200SLSA is for SLSA. F-1200 will be referenced in the text for the remainder of this section."

In Figure 1 remove the depiction of the ELSA placard. Remove the ELSA and SLSA callouts.

Depict the passenger warning placard, described in '42D-31' above, on the instrument panel.
