Synopsis:

Installations have been found in the field without a proper pipe plug installed in the fuel spider gauge port. Note new engines do not come with this plug installed.

Method of Compliance:

<u>Step 1:</u> Remove the top cowling or look up through the right cowl air inlet duct and verify that the proper F 1/8 PIPE PLUG is installed in the gauge port of the fuel spider. If the incorrect fitting is installed order and install the correct plug from Van's Aircraft. For further information on installation of fluid fittings see Section 5.27.
