

## **Apprentice Aircraft Painter**

Essential responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Sanding or scuffing aluminum surfaces in preparation for priming.
- Light fiberglass finishing work, including filling and sanding.
- Spraying high-build primer on fiberglass surfaces in preparation for painting.
- Prepping aluminum surfaces for prime and paint (wipe, blow, tack).
- Masking surfaces using tape, paper, plastic, and stencils.
- Cleaning pots and guns after each application.
- Maintaining a clean and organized work area.
- Periodically cleaning paint booth and replacing booth filters to eliminate dust and debris.

## Requirements:

- Wear proper PPE, including Tyvek suit, respirator, and gloves.
- Work well as an individual and as an integral part of a cohesive team.
- Ability to work on belly of aircraft from the ground (creeper is provided).
- Ability to move and lift up to 50 lbs.
